## 'Good to be me'

The theme for this half term's work on developing children's social, emotional and behavioural skills will be '**Good to be me**'. We will be exploring how children can motivate themselves in their learning and across the school.

This theme will start with an assembly and be followed up in class.

### Year 3 and 4

Children will be taught:

- To talk and write about their opinions, and explain their views on issues that affect themselves and society.
- To recognise their worth as individuals, by identifying positive things about themselves and their achievements, seeing their mistakes, making amends and setting personal goals.
- To reflect on spiritual, moral, social and cultural issues, using imagination to understand other people's experiences.
- To see that their actions affect themselves and others and to care about other people's feelings, trying to see things from their point of view.
- To be aware of different types of relationships and to develop the skills to be effective in relationships.
