'New Beginnings'

The theme for this half term's work on developing children's social, emotional and behavioural skills will be **'New Beginnings'**. We will be exploring how children can motivate themselves in their learning and across the school.

This theme will start with an assembly and be followed up in class.

Year 3 and 4

Children will be taught:

- To know something about everyone in the class
- To know that children are valued in school
- To know how to make someone feel welcome and valued.
- To know what it feels like to be unwelcome.
- To know how to join a group.
- To be able to tell someone one special thing about themselves.
- To know how it feels to be excited, scared, happy or sad and can usually tell if other people are feeling these emotions.
- To be able to predict how they are going to feel in new situations or when meeting new people.
- To know how it feels to start something new and some ways to cope with these feelings.
- To know how to manage feelings and to find ways of calming down if necessary.
- To learn how to give and accept a compliment.
- To find more ways of solving a problem.
- To understand rights and responsibilities at school.
- To know why there are different rules in different places and to know school rules.
